PLANNING BOARD/PUBLIC WORKS

COUNCILMAN BONSALL

In Councilman Bonsall's absence, Mayor Campbell commended the great job done by Public Works during the January blizzard. Planning Board did not meet this month.

PUBLIC EVENTS

COUNCILMAN BROWN

Councilman Brown announced that the Annual Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, March 19. The raindate will be March 26.

POLICE/LIBRARY

COUNCILMAN CROGHAN

No report was made due to Councilman Croghan's absence. Three new police patrolmen were sworn in earlier in the meeting.

TRASH & RECYLING/HEALTH

COUNCILMAN DETERDING

In December of 2015, 93 tons of trash and 33 tons of recycling were collected.

RECREATION/L&I

COUNCILMAN MACFERREN

In December of 2015, \$1,797 was collected in L&I construction fees. In January of 2016, \$4,676 was collected. For recreation, Councilman MacFerren is working with the Borough engineer to determine the specifications for benches to be installed at Lauer Playground and on the bike trails. We should find out whether the County awards the borough a recreation grant by the end of March.

INSURANCE/ENVIRONMENTAL

COUNCILMAN FLYNN

Councilman Flynn reported that there was one insurance claim of \$4,900 filed in January for the motor vehicle accident which damaged the streetscape at the corner of Clementon Road and Foster Avenue. A subcommittee of the Environmental Commission has been meeting bi-monthly to create a community garden at Pole Hill Park. To raise funds for the garden project, grants have been applied for, area businesses are being solicited for donations, and a Garden Party will be held at the Senior Center on April 16. The party will feature food, education, poster contest and more. The "Gibbsboro Community Garden" is an active Facebook page that all are encouraged to join. An Irish Potatoes fundraiser is underway and runs until St. Patrick's Day. The Green Team is working toward Sustainable Jersey certification. One action item with Sustainable Jersey that is particularly valuable is identifying vulnerable citizens for emergency purposes. Another is a Buy Local campaign.

MAYOR'S REPORT

MAYOR CAMPBELL

The Annual Financial Statement was filed. Our fund balance is \$1,328,520.75 which was up from last year; however, the challenges are going to start. The Sewer fund balance is steady at approximately \$189,000. No increase to the annual sewer fee is needed in 2016; however, it does continue to decline and we are carrying a debt to Voorhees. The goal is to get more ratables in town soon. The budget will be introduced in March. A Town Crier will be going out shortly.
