**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Gibbsboro (the “Borough”) desires to make application to the Local Finance Board for its approval to adopt the following refunding bond ordinances:

1. Refunding Bond Ordinance of the Borough of Gibbsboro, in the County of Camden, New Jersey Providing for the Current Refunding of Certain General Improvement Refunding Bonds, Series 1998, Appropriating \$285,000 therefor and Authorizing the Issuance of \$285,000 General Improvement Refunding Bonds of the Borough for Financing the Cost Thereof; and
2. Refunding Bond Ordinance of the Borough of Gibbsboro, in the County of Camden, New Jersey Providing for the Current Refunding of Certain Sewer Utility Refunding Bonds, Series 1998, Appropriating \$1,850,000 therefor and Authorizing the Issuance of \$1,850,000 Sewer Utility Refunding Bonds of the Borough for Financing the Cost Thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, Borough believes that:

- (a) it is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose;
- (b) said purpose or improvements are for the health, welfare, convenience or betterment of the inhabitants of the local unit or units;
- (c) the amounts to be expended for said purpose or improvements are not unreasonable or exorbitant;

(d) the proposal is an efficient and feasible means of providing services for the needs of the inhabitants of the local unit or units and will not create an undue financial burden to be placed upon the local unit or units;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BOROUGH COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The application to the Local Finance Board is hereby approved, and the Borough’s Bond Counsel along with other representatives of the Borough, are hereby authorized to prepare such application and to represent the Borough in matters pertaining thereto.

**Section 2.** The Clerk of the Borough is hereby directed to prepare and file a copy of the proposed ordinance and this resolution with the Local Finance Board as part of such application.

**Section 3.** The Local Finance Board is hereby respectfully requested to consider such application and to record its approvals as provided by the applicable New Jersey Statute.
