The Sherwin-Williams Project Team will be working in your area the weeks of **November 15, 2015 through December 20, 2015**

This work will involve:

marking of subsurface utilities in preparation for soil sampling;
surveying of select properties within the project area;
collection of geophysical data and groundwater samples from existing monitoring wells;
soil sampling along Hilliards Creek behind West Clementon Road;
and soil sampling along United States Avenue.

We have obtained access agreements from the appropriate property owners for this work. If we anticipate accessing your property, we will call you at least 48-hours in advance. During this timeframe, you may see our project team and their equipment near your property. As with previous activities, we will make every effort possible to minimize disruptions to the neighborhood.
