Mayor White served as a member of Council for nine years and eight additional years as Mayor. After leaving office as Mayor he served the town as Construction Official, Zoning Officer, and Compliance Officer, positions he held until his death. Flags in the Borough were lowered to half staff in honor of Mayor White's unselfish service to our community.

Mayor White is survived by his wife Louise, son John E. White Jr, daughters Kathryn and Mary, three grandchildren, and two sisters.

1. Enclose check or money order payable to: Borough of Gibbsboro.

Additional Fees: Non-neutered/Non-spayed Dogs/Cats	\$ 3.00
Late Fee (for payments after Mar 31)	\$ 25.00
2. Enclose current rabies certificate, valid through October 2009, and proof of neutering or spaying.
3. Enclose Veterinarian's certificate stating your dog/cat has been neutered or spayed. If you do not have a certificate, add three dollars (\$3.00) to the cost of the license.
4. Complete and return application to Borough of Gibbsboro, 49 Kirkwood Road, Gibbsboro, NJ 08026 with certificates for rabies inoculation and evidence of spay/neutering.
5. If mailing payment, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
