

In Memoriam

Mayor DiRocco was Gibbsboro's only female Mayor and served our community in many capacities including as a member of the local Women's Club, member of Borough Council and as our Mayor. Flags in the Borough were lowered to half staff in honor of Mayor DiRocco's unselfish service to our community. She was a Gibbsboro resident for more than fifty years.

Mayor DiRocco is survived by her daughter Deborah J. DiRocco of Gibbsboro and Joseph A. DiRocco and wife Susan of Hollister, CA, and her sister Lucretia Virgilio of Glen Mills, PA. Also surviving are many nieces and nephews.

AROUND TOWN

Record Winter Pounds Gibbsboro – Federal Disaster Declared - The snowstorm of December 19-20 that dumped over 24 inches of snow on Gibbsboro and the surrounding area has been declared eligible for federal disaster funds. Gibbsboro is seeking federal reimbursement of eligible snow removal costs.

Zoning Board Approves Chophouse Variance – The Chophouse approval will permit an expansion and reconfiguration of their bar area along Silver Lake that will include an open air bar. The firm will need to obtain approval from the Zoning Board of a revised Site Plan, including architectural plans, prior to commencing construction.

Planning Board Grants Final Site Plan Approval for Office Building on Lake View Drive – The plan calls for the construction of 9,853 square feet of office space at 68 North Lake View Drive. As part of the approval the applicant will create a conservation easement in favor of the Borough on over four acres of wetlands and buffer that will connect municipal lands that border the applicant's property. The proposed office building will conform to the Borough's architectural and streetscape guidelines and extend the streetscape toward the Voorhees border. The applicant, the Frasca Irrevocable Trust, plans to begin construction in 2010.

Architect's rendering of the Frasca Irrevocable Trust Office Building




