For the first time since the Police Department has been unionized, the Gibbsboro Police Association and the Borough of Gibbsboro reached a collective bargaining agreement prior to the expiration of the contract.

Full time police will receive competitive pay increases and improvements in their clothing allowance. Officers will also receive a higher payment for performing third party assignments, which are not paid by the Borough.

Police will receive an annual payout of unused sick time at a rate 65 cents per dollar accrued. Sick time will no longer accrue from year to year. This eliminates a Borough liability which grows as salaries grow without a source of funding.

Police began contributing toward their health care costs in January, in accordance with state law.

The agreement was approved by a unanimous vote of the Borough Council and the new accord will run through December 31, 2016.
