

# November 3, 2020 – General Election

## FAQ's

### 1. How do I register to vote?

The last day to register to vote for the 2020 General Election is October 13<sup>th</sup>. To register, visit State Division of Elections at <https://nj.gov/state/elections/vote.shtml>.

### 2. Will I receive a Vote by Mail (VBM) Ballot?

All registered voters will automatically be sent a VBM Ballot. Ballots will be mailed beginning the week of September 21<sup>st</sup> through October 5<sup>th</sup>. After the initial mailing, anyone who registers to vote will be sent a ballot soon after registration. All ballots will include an instruction insert describing how to correctly vote your ballot.

### 3. How do I return my VBM Ballot?

Your VBM Ballot will include instructions on how to return your voted ballot as well as drop box locations. You can return your voted ballot *by mail* (all postage paid), *to the Board of Elections* in Blackwood, NJ (during normal business hours), *to any Camden County Ballot Drop Box* (see list below), or *to your Polling Place on Election Day*.

The *deadline to mail or drop off VBM Ballots* to be counted is November 3<sup>rd</sup> by 8PM – at the Board of Elections, your Polling Place, or in a Camden County Drop Box. Mailed ballots *with a postmark* on or before November 3<sup>rd</sup> will be counted *if they are received by 8PM on November 10<sup>th</sup>*. Mailed ballots *without a postmark* will be counted *if they are received by 8PM on November 5<sup>th</sup>*.

### 4. What if I need a replacement VBM ballot?

If you need a *replacement ballot*, you can request one by visiting [www.camdencounty.com/vbm2](http://www.camdencounty.com/vbm2). The deadline to request a duplicate ballot *by mail* is October 23<sup>rd</sup> or *in person* by 8PM on November 3<sup>rd</sup> (Election Day). In person requests can be made at the County Clerk's Office in Blackwood, NJ.

### 5. What if I want to vote at the polls?

Voters who wish to vote at the polls may do so *by Provisional (paper) Ballot*. There will be one voting machine at each Polling Place for use by *disabled voters only*.

### 6. Where is my polling place?

A *postcard* will be sent (in lieu of a Sample Ballot) with your Polling Place listed.

Gibbsboro's Polling Place for Districts 1 & 2 is the American Legion Post 371, which will be open from 6AM-8PM for in person voting.

## 7. What if I have moved recently?

If you have moved within the County, you can complete a change of address form to update your voter registration. If you have moved within the State but to a different County or are a new resident in the State of New Jersey, you must complete a new voter registration. Updates and new voter registrations can be completed by visiting the State Division of Elections at <https://nj.gov/state/elections/vote.shtml>.

## 8. How do I know if I'm registered to vote?

## 9. How do I know if my vote has been counted?

## 10. Will I receive a Sample Ballot?

No Sample Ballots will be sent this year. Post cards will be sent in lieu of Sample Ballots.

There are 13 Ballot Drop Boxes in Camden County. All boxes are available 24/7, are in well-lit locations, and are under 24-hour video surveillance. Collections are made every 24 hours.
