





1 AN ACT requiring the creation and issuance of license plates for
2 qualified veterans to allow parking in parking spots reserved for
3 persons with a disability and supplementing Title 39 of the
4 Revised Statutes.

6 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
7 of New Jersey:

8

9 1. a. For the purposes of P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before
10 the Legislature as this bill), "disabled veteran" means a resident of
11 this State who is certified by the federal Department of Veterans
12 Affairs as having any degree of service-connected disability.

13 b. The Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle
14 Commission shall, upon proper application thereof, issue a qualified
15 disabled veteran license plate for any motor vehicle owned or
16 leased and registered in the State by a disabled veteran. In addition
17 to the registration number and other markings or identification
18 otherwise prescribed by law, the license plate shall display the
19 words "Disabled Veteran" and a wheelchair symbol. Issuance of
20 qualified disabled veteran license plates shall be subject to the
21 provisions of chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, except as
22 hereinafter otherwise specifically provided.

23 c. Application for issuance of qualified disabled veteran license
24 plates shall be made to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission
25 in a form and manner as prescribed by the chief administrator.
26 There shall be no cost to the applicant for these license plates.

27 d. A qualified disabled veteran license plate is not transferable
28 and is exclusively for the use of the person to whom it is duly
29 issued.

30 e. The chief administrator shall notify motorists of the
31 availability of license plates for qualified disabled veterans by
32 including a notice with all motor vehicle registration renewals and
33 by posting appropriate posters or signs in all motor vehicle
34 commission facilities and offices, as may be provided by the New
35 Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission. The notices, posters, and signs
36 shall be designed by the chief administrator.

37

1 New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission in order to park in a
2 parking space or zone pursuant to this section, provided that the
3 person displays the person's valid, unexpired qualified disabled
4 veteran license plate on the motor vehicle while parked in that
5 parking space or zone.

6 b. The knowing misuse or abuse of any benefit, privilege, or
7 consideration granted to a holder of a qualified disabled veteran
8 license plate shall be sufficient cause for the revocation of all
9 benefits, privileges, and considerations afforded to the holder of the
10 special license plate and the forfeiture of the qualified disabled
11 veteran license plate.

13 3. This act shall take effect on the first day of the sixth month
14 following enactment. The Chief Administrator of the New Jersey
15 Motor Vehicle Commission may take such anticipatory acts in
16 advance of the date as may be necessary for the timely
17 implementation of this act.

STATEMENT

21

22 This bill requires the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey
23 Motor Vehicle Commission to issue special license plates for
24 qualified disabled veterans.

25 The plates allow disabled veterans to park in a parking space or
26 zone that is restricted for use by a person with a disability, provided
27 that the disabled veteran displays the veteran's valid, unexpired
28 qualified disabled veteran license plate on the motor vehicle while
29 parked in the parking space or zone.

30 Under the bill, these special plates are to display the words
31 "Disabled Veteran" and a wheelchair symbol. There is to be no
32 cost to the applicant for these special license plates.

33 Finally, the bill specifies that these plates are not transferable
34 and are exclusively for the use of the person to whom they are duly
35 issued. The knowing misuse or abuse of any benefit, privilege, or
36 consideration granted to a holder of a qualified disabled veteran
