IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW...

- Arrive at **1:30 p.m.** at Gibbsboro School on April 18th. Come dressed in your **casual attire** for your interview with the judges. The questions will be very general so just relax and be yourself!
- Judging will be based on several factors: appearance, poise, personality, and speech presentation.
- Come prepared with a **2-2.5 minute speech** on your goals and aspirations. Contestants will present their speech at the pageant. You may bring note cards to read from. Here are a few tips for preparing your speech:
 - Don't rush – speak slowly and clearly.
 - Take deep breaths, especially if you feel jittery.
 - Find a friendly face in the audience to make eye contact with, or look at the back wall if faces make you nervous, but remember to look up after every few sentences.
 - Practice – most people feel nervous when speaking in public, but the more prepared you are, the better!
- Bring your **formal attire** (gown or dressy dress) to change into for the second half of the pageant. Don't forget a change of shoes and jewelry if that is part of your formal attire.
- If you have a **flower girl** (ages 4-8) from town that would like to participate, please let us know their name and how to contact them.
- We encourage all contestants to also participate in the **essay contest** (this is not a requirement).
- Make sure you have submitted your **fact sheet**. This information will be shared with the judges before your interview, and used by the emcee to introduce you during the pageant. You can submit it by hand to the Borough Hall or by email to friendsofgibbsboro@gmail.com
